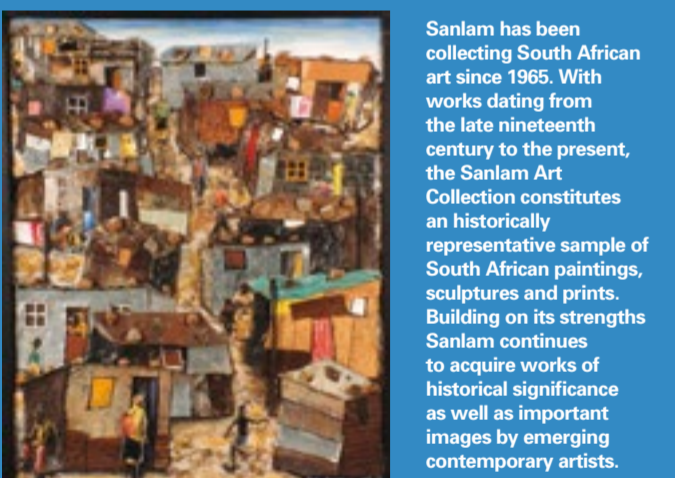

Vusi Khumalo (1951 –), *Maputo Informal Settlement*, 1996, mixed media collage on board, Sanlam Art Collection



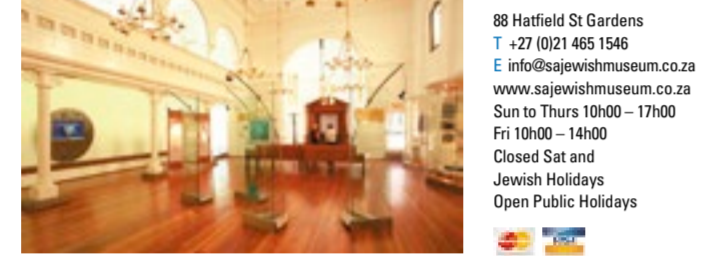

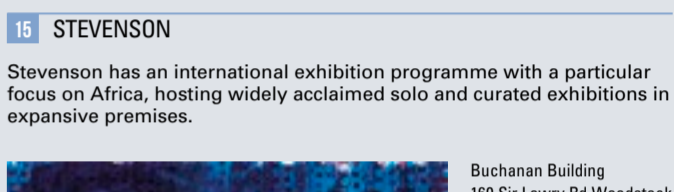
13 ZEITZ MOCCA
