01 ROBBEN ISLAND MUSEUM

Robben Island Museum is a World Heritage Site, and is arguably best known for the maximum-security prison, where Nelson Mandela was incarcerated. A visit to the island will however reveal its multi-layered history that dates back to the early 1300s and offers a bespoke public and cultural heritage experience that stretches beyond Madiba's cell, to include among others the Sobukwe Complex. Lime-stone quarry and visitors centre, while simultaneously offering an array of natural wildlife in this marine protected site. Daily tours are conducted and include a personalised tour of the maximum security prison, narrated by former political prisoners through memories and experiences

All ferries depart from Nelson Mandela Gateway, ClockTowe precinct, V&A Waterfront.





D IZIKO SLAVE LODGE (ISL)

E IZIKO BO-KAAP MUSEUM (IBK)

F KOOPMANS-DE WET HOUSE (IKDW)

The oldest house museum in the country, Iziko Koopmans de Wet House was origi built as a home for a well-to-do Cape family during the late 18th century. 35 Strand Street, Cape Town | Closed: Saturday to Wednesday, Workers' Day & Christmas Day.

6 WILLIAM FEHR COLLECTION

The William Fehr Collection contains fine and interesting paintings and decorative arts of special relevance to the Cape's wealth of historical information—especially concerning peoples and landscapes of early colonial South Africa. The collection is exhibited at the Castle of Good Hope and Rust en Vreugd (see below), both historic buildings. Castle of Good Hope, Darling Street | Closed: Christmas Day & New Year's Day.

H RUST & VREUGD

Rust en Vreugd was built as a home for Willem Cornelius Boers, a high-ranking official for the VOC (Dutch East India Company), between 1777 and 1778. Today a museum, it showcases a selection of William Fehr's collection of drawings, watercolours and print 78 Buitenkant Street, Cape Town I Closed: Saturday to Wednesday, Workers' Day & Christmas Day.

I GROOT CONSTANTIA MANOR HOUSE

Groot Constantia dates back to 1685, making it one of South Africa's oldest commercia wine farms. Not only does it boast an admirable exhibition of historical furniture and paintings but on display are historical wine cellars and drinking vessels. It was from this wine farm that exiled French ruler Napoleon Bonaparte was supplied with his favorite wine. Groot Constantia is a treat for both locals as well as tourists.
