01 ROBBER ISLAND MUSEUM

Robben Island Museum is a World Heritage Site, and is arguably best known for the maximum-security prison, where Nelson Mandela was incarcerated. A visit to the island will however reveal its multi-layered history that dates back to the early 1300s and offers a bespoke public and cultural heritage experience that stretches beyond Madiba's cell, to include among others the Sobukwe Complex, Lime-stone quarry and visitors centre, while simultaneously offering an array of natural wildlife in this marine protected site. Daily tours are conducted and include a personalised tour of the maximum security prison, narrated by former political prisoners through memories and experiences.

All ferries depart from Nelson Mandela Gateway, Clock Tower precinct, V&A Waterfront.

A IZIKO SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL GALLERY (ISANG)
Visit the Iziko South African National Gallery for a visual feast of artistic expression spanning diverse genres of historical and contemporary art from Africa and the globe. Selections from the Permanent Collection change regularly to enable the museum to have a full programme of temporary exhibitions of paintings, works on paper, photography, sculpture, beadwork, textiles and architecture.

B IZIKO SOUTH AFRICAN MUSEUM (ISAM)

D IZIKO SLAVE LODGE (ISL)
Visit the Iziko Slave Lodge, rediscover your roots and connect with our histories. The Slave Lodge is one of the oldest buildings in Cape Town. Under the umbrella theme, 'From human wrongs to human rights', exhibitions of this museum explore the long history of slavery in and struggle history in Cape Town.

E IZIKO BO-KAAP MUSEUM (IBK)
Explore the early expansion of the city, racial and spatial discrimination, and working life in Cape Town at the Izik Bo Kaap Museum. The Effendis of 71 Wale Street, Bo Kaap shares the untold story of the Effendis family who lived in the house, today the Bo Kaap Museum, before the forced removals of the 1970's.

F IZIKO OLD TOWN HOUSE
Sited in the hub of Cape Town on Greenmarket Square, and built in 1755 in the Cape Rococo style, the Old Town House formerly acted as the Cape Town City Hall and today houses the Michaelis Collection.

G WILLIAM FEHR COLLECTION
The William Fehr Collection contains fine and interesting paintings and decorative arts of special relevance to the Cape's wealth of historical information – especially concerning peoples and landscapes of early colonial South Africa. The collection is exhibited at the Castle of Good Hope and Rust en Vreugd (see below), both historic buildings.
Castle of Good Hope, Darling Street | Closed: Christmas Day & New Year's Day.

H RUST & VREUGD
Rust en Vreugd was built as a home for Willem Cornelius Boers, a high-ranking official for the VOC (Dutch East India Company), between 1771 and 1778. Today a museum, it showcases a selection of William Fehr's collection of drawings, watercolours and print art works.

I GROOT CONSTANTIA MANOR HOUSE
Groot Constantia dates back to 1685, making it one of South Africa's oldest commercial wine farms. Not only does it boast an admirable exhibition of historical furniture and paintings but on display are historical wine cellars and drinking vessels.
It was from this wine farm that exiled French ruler Napoleon Bonaparte was supplied with his favorite wine. Groot Constantia is a treat for both locals as well as tourists.
